### ***LOCATION & COURSES***

Situated on the foreshore of the world's busiest passenger ferry port, Dover Water Sports has over a square mile of sheltered water where we provide practical, water-based tuition in dinghy sailing, windsurfing, raft-building, power-boating and keel boats. We can give you the excitement of sea sailing, but in a safe environment. We also offer instructor training and a range of shore-based courses to compliment our water-based courses and allow you to build on what you have learnt afloat.

We provide group sessions, courses for individuals or private tuition tailored to the needs of our customers of all ages and abilities ranging from complete beginners to experienced seafarers. We can also provide corporate fun days, team building events and celebration parties. Dover Water Sports has a range of boats, from Taz dinghies to performance craft and can provide keel boat training and experiences aboard our MacWester 26, the yacht 'Wongga'. We also have windsurfers and a range of rigid inflatable boats.

It is our aim to use the sea for education and skill training in seamanship, character formation and personal development, including physical education and life saving and other activities for young people participating in the Duke of Edinburgh's Award Scheme. ## TASTER SESSIONS

## ADULT SAILING

### **RYA LEVEL 1 (START SAILING)** **£220**

Power and keel boating are generally drier sports; however Windsurfing, Canoeing, and Dinghy sailing are considered wet sports.

Whilst Dover Water Sports does have a supply of wetsuits, we cannot guarantee to provide one for everybody. We recommend that you bring:

- Swimming costume or trunks
- towel
- an old t-shirt or fleece
- shorts or lightweight long trousers to use while sailing
- a pair of trainers or similar that you will not mind getting wet.
- a lightweight windproof jacket
- sun hat
- sun protection cream
